The City of Penticton's **Public Works Department** is in search of a highly skilled and energetic individual for the full-time permanent position of **Senior Pipelayer**. The Public Works department keeps our community safe by providing clean, safe drinking water, a reliable sanitary sewer system, and storm-water drainage to help prevent flooding. This department manages the roads in our community, as well as the parks and cemetery, and collects your garbage and recycling. To help support these services, as well as those delivered by other departments, the Public Works department also manages the City's fleet of vehicles.

Reporting to the Public Works Utilities Supervisor, the **Senior Pipelayer** performs skilled maintenance, repair and installation tasks involving domestic, agricultural and effluent water distribution, sanitary sewers and storm sewer systems. The Senior Pipelayer is an integral member of the Utilities team working on all facets of the City of Penticton's Utility Infrastructure.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provides job site supervision and direction to Utility Crew and contractors in absence of Utilities Foreman.
- Assists the Utilities Foreman in planning, organizing and problem solving as it relates to all aspects of Utilities.
- Supervises and assists with location of underground utilities and performing BC 1 Calls.
- Ensures adherence to the City of Penticton's safe work procedures, practices and WCB regulations.
- Performs daily tailboard talks with staff members.
- Assists in the operation, maintenance and repair of sanitary sewer system, storm water system and water distribution system.
- Installs new utility services as directed by Utilities Supervisor and/or Utilities Foreman.
- Assist with field collection of GIS related information using the Trimble R2 or equivalent.

- Level II EOCP Water Distribution Certification.
- Level 1 EOCP Waste Water Collection Certification.
- Minimum 3 years' experience in municipal utility and road construction.
- Valid Class 3 Drivers' Licence with Air Endorsement.
- Courses and certificates in WHMIS, TDG, First Aid, Fall Arrest, Confined Space Entry, Asbestos Handling, Utility Locates.
- Thorough knowledge of municipal infrastructure maintenance, construction and operation principals, safe work practices and applicable safety regulations as they relate to Public Works Operations.
- Necessary knowledge of Utility locating equipment and metal detectors.
- Operating knowledge of fire hydrants, pumps, water meters, pressure reducing valves, air release valves, reduced pressure backflow devices, DCVA's and related utility equipment.
- Ability to read, comprehend and interpret construction plans and specifications.
- Ability to keep accurate written and digital documentation of daily duties performed.
- Ability to perform heavy manual labor in various weather conditions.
