In addition, the Superintendent, in conjunction with the other Public Works Superintendents, coordinates priorities and operationalizes plans for all Public Works activities. The Superintendent exercises a considerable degree of independent judgment and action on all technical aspects of the work.

The Roads and Drainage Superintendent is a strong leader who has considerable experience working in a municipal setting and is interested in being part of an exciting team. The ideal candidate will have completed post-secondary education in a related field, as well as have 10 years' experience in a municipal works setting, including considerable demonstrated supervisory experience.
